Gaining an international perspective can increase your desirability to a variety of employers and will complement several academic fields, all of which can benefit from an increase in cross-cultural skills. Courses in the Global Studies Certificate courses are eligible for transfer to other colleges and universities.				
Psychology	Associate of Arts	In this program we will explore mental processes, social influences, the development process and how each of these areas influence humans and our behavior. During the pursuit of this degree students will utilize the scientific method, to explore humanity, doing so with a theoretical focus. Psychology is a vast field with many possible focus areas which allow students to work with, and explore, human behavior from a vast number of viewpoints.	The AA in Psychology curriculum is designed for flexibility and broad applicability to four-year transfer institutions. Since Baccalaureate degree requirements vary from institution to institution, the course options within each category are intended to provide a broad base of psychology and general education courses that fulfill many requirements at various colleges and universities in our region.				

Students who graduate from these programs are not eligible for specific exams, licenses, or credentials, but often complete pre-requisite coursework for advanced degrees at other institutions. Required supplies are dependent upon the courses students select. For example, some art or science courses may require specific supplies or include lab fees. Uniforms are not required.

The SCC Experience

- The Academic Transfer program offers both an Associate of Arts and an Associate of Science degree.

 The **Associate of Arts** degree allows students to focus their study on liberal arts coursework such as language, humanities, religious, social sciences, fine arts, etc. preparing students to transfer and complete a bachelor's degree in areas like education, psychology, music, social work, history, and more! The **Associate of Science** degree gives students the opportunity to focus their study on math and science courses, preparing them to complete a bachelor's degree in science, engineering, math, and more. Students in the Associate of Science focus their study in math and science to prepare them for advanced coursework in those areas. The result of these offerings is that SCC Academic Transfer graduates are prepared for any future educational goals!
- >>> Academic Transfer students benefit from intentional advising. Each SCC student is assigned two advisors to support and guide them as they work toward their goals. The College Advisor is well connected to four-year school representatives and is trained to specifically advise transfer students on requirements. The faculty advisor is an expert in their field of study and connects students with opportunities in and out of the classroom, based on the student's interests. Both advisors are committed to student success and are available to answer questions for students.
- >>> SCC's Academic Transfer faculty are among the best! Our faculty are highly qualified, with more than one-third holding doctoral degrees. Students learn in small class sizes and receive individual attention from qualified experts rather than teaching assistants.
- >>> The Academic Transfer program is committed to real-life experiences for students in and out of the classroom. In the classroom, students participate in engaged learning activities that equip them with essential skills such as teamwork, critical thinking, communication, and more. Outside of the classroom, students can participate in music and theatre ensembles and performances, internships and practicums, service learning projects, the annual speech contest, department clubs such as the Psychology/Sociology Club, Chemistry Club, or Humanities Club, the College's newspaper or creative works publication, or travel in the U.S. and abroad through study away and global education trips.
- >>> At SCC, those pursuing an AA in Psychology and intending to transfer into the 4-year level, are afforded several opportunities early on in their degree pathway including the Psychology/Sociology Club where they can meet like-minded peers, explore the field in more in-depth ways and foster connections with faculty beyond the classroom. Students are able to pursue internships in a psychology related field and receive college credit. Students are also able to participate in several opportunities to grow their research and presentation experience.
- Our Global Studies Certificate program affords students a small investment with a big return. Students who have other career interests but want to show their employer their commitment to global issues can add this certificate to any other existing degree and, with some foresight and intention, take classes that they would need for several other degree programs. One of the options of this coursework includes an internship related to Global Issues, allowing students an early-career opportunity to explore and further determine interests as well as areas that may not be a good fit.
